To mark the foundation of the <u>Aubrey Beardsley Society</u>, the Prize for the best short essay on any aspect of Beardsley's work, life, and reception will be awarded to an outstanding emerging scholar. Eligibility

- Postgraduate (MA, MPhil, PhD) and early career researchers who have not held a permanent academic post are invited to participate.
- The participants should join the Aubrey Beardsley Society (discounted membership).
- Essays should be up to 2,500 words and formatted in accordance with the MHRA style.

The amount of the Emerging Beardsley Scholar Prize is £500. Two runners-up will be awarded £100, and the three winning pieces will be published in the <u>AB Blog</u>. The Prize is supported by the <u>Alessandra Wilson Fund</u>.
